



Bavarian Graduate Program in Economics

Course announcement “Advanced Microeconomics”

The Bavarian Graduate Program in Economics (BGPE) invites contributions to the next BGPE course “**Advanced Microeconomics**”.

The course will take place on **September 20-25, 2020** and will be taught by Zvika Neeman from the Eitan Berglas School of Economics, Tel-Aviv University.

Preference will be given to Ph.D. students in Economics from the following Bavarian universities: Augsburg, Bamberg, Bayreuth, Eichstätt-Ingolstadt, Erlangen-Nürnberg, Passau, Regensburg, TU Munich, and Würzburg. The BGPE covers their course fee incl. costs of meals (no drinks), and accommodation in double rooms. The BGPE does not cover any travel expenses. The students are expected to take part in the final exam after the course on October 16, 2020.

Students from other, in particular non-Bavarian, Ph.D. programs or from the LMU Munich can participate if the course is not fully booked and if they pay a fee of 1,000 Euro per person in advance. The fee will cover the course itself, costs of meals (no drinks), accommodation in double rooms, and the option to take part in the exam.

After successful participation in the final exam, you will receive a BGPE course certificate.

The application deadline is **August 16, 2020**. For further information (incl. course description and application form) please check www.bgpe.de. Notices of acceptance are usually sent about 4 weeks before the course.
