## Course announcement “Empirical Public Finance”

The Bavarian Graduate Program in Economics (BGPE) invites contributions to the next BGPE course “**Empirical Public Finance**”. The course will take place on **March 22 - 26, 2021** and will be taught by Daniel Waldenström from the IFN, Stockholm.

Preference will be given to Ph.D. students in Economics from the following Bavarian universities: Augsburg, Bamberg, Bayreuth, Eichstätt-Ingolstadt, Erlangen-Nürnberg, LMU Munich, Passau, Regensburg, TU Munich and Würzburg. Due to the current situation the course will take place virtually. The students are expected to take part in the exam. Examination: Classroom participation (article presentations) and written home exam.

Students from other, in particular non-Bavarian, Ph.D. programs can participate if the course is not fully booked and if they pay a fee of 500 Euro per person in advance. The fee will cover the course itself and the option to take part in the exam.

After successful participation in the final exam, you will receive a BGPE course certificate.
